Kit Review

Missing Link Resin's 1977/78 Ford Mustang II Cobra

Ok, here is a first for me. I am going to review a conversion kit from a resin company. This kit comes with body, hood, grill, bumpers, front and rear spoilers, side window louvers, factory correct chrome wheels, tail lights and bezels. To complete this kit you will need the AMT 1976 Mustang II. This is a very clean resin kit with very little flash. The front and rear spoilers as well as the side louvers are what really make this a Cobra II as opposed to regular Mustang II. So why add a body that is a mirror copy of the AMT? Setting the two bodies side by side and it is clear to see that the Missing Link body is much better quality than the AMT. However, the Missing Link Body does not have an opening rear hatch. Actually this is what makes the body better and stiffer as well.
